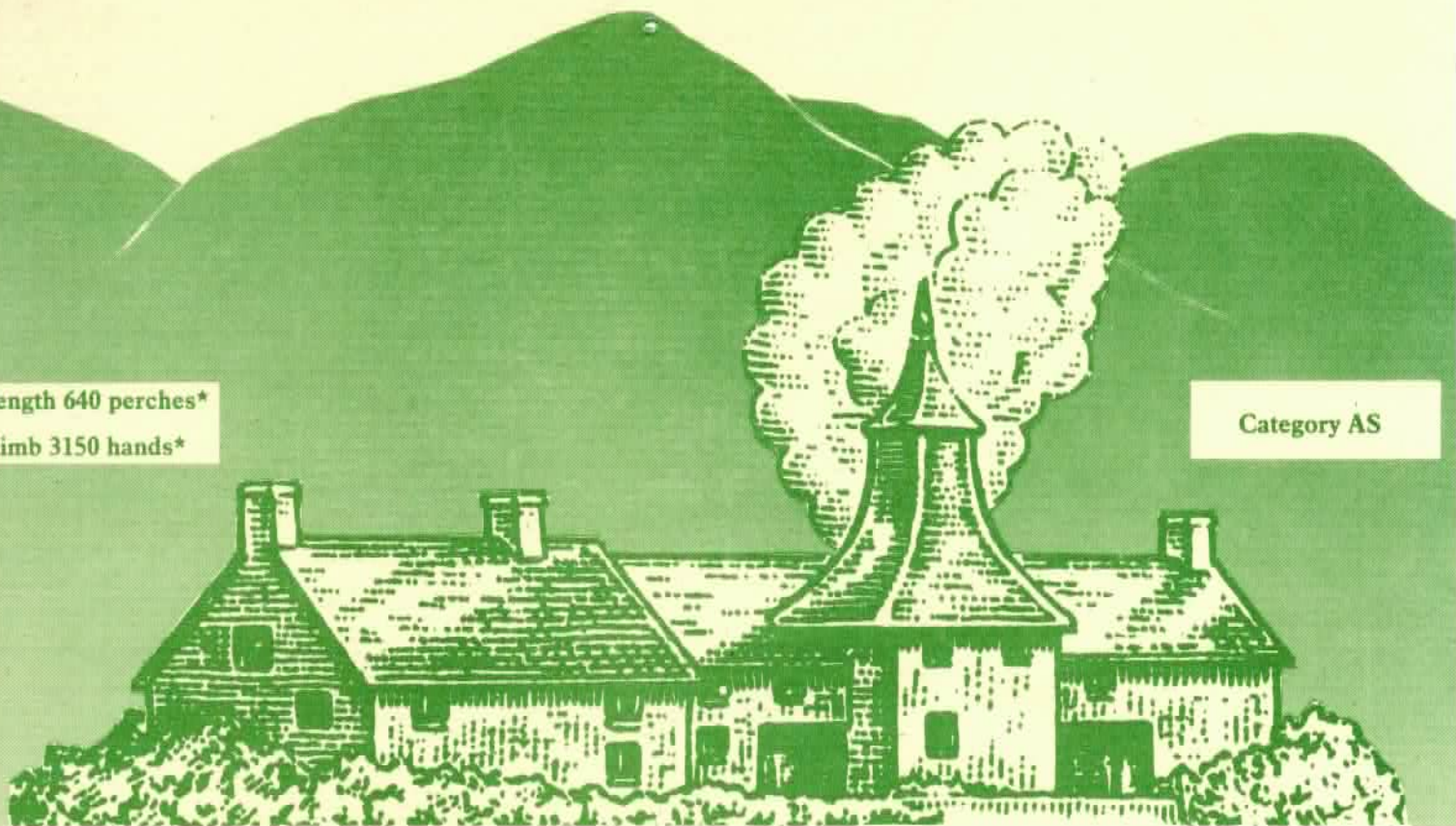

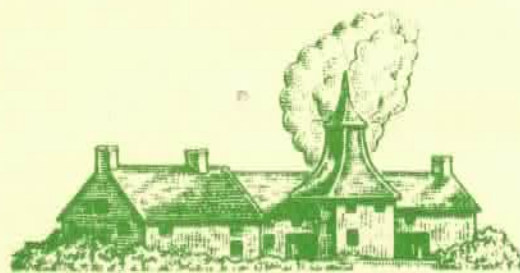
Yes, it's the inimitable Dumgoyne hill race with all its glories—the stile, the view and the last suicide slope with the hidden wall. Ye cannae whack it!
